2. Group membership

General discussion was held on the membership and role of the group with suggestions of potential new members which Third Energy said they would consider.

The Group also discussed the suggestion of holding one meeting for the three Parish Councils in the area to focus on the KM8 project. Third Energy will continue correspondence with the Clerks of each of the three Councils on this matter.

3. KM8 Hydraulic Fracture Plan – presentation by John Dewar

John Dewar made a presentation and answered questions on the Hydraulic Fracture Plan that had been submitted to the Oil & Gas Authority and the Environment Agency earlier in July.

4. Any other business:
  - a. Concern was expressed over potential negative impact on house prices and whether or not there would be a compensation scheme for villagers if this were to happen. Third Energy stated that there was no compensation scheme.
  - b. Clarification requested on the community benefits scheme – how the money is applied for, allocated etc.
  - c. It was noted that the North Yorkshire Police will be attending the next Kirby Misperton Parish Council meeting.
  - d. Request Third Energy to inform residents if there were routine maintenance activities with the potential to cause odour in the village so that they were forewarned
