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### **Composition**

Nicky Mason suggested she could represent Habton Parish Council but a local resident would be needed. It was suggested that there should also be a parish council / resident representative from Great and Little Barugh.

It was noted that there had been no response had been received from Cllr Lyndsay Burr regarding her invitation to the group. Luke Richardson volunteered to try and contact Cllr Burr to ascertain her interest in joining the group. If Cllr Burr declines, another NYCC councillor will be invited.

The group also has a spare place currently listed as AN Other. It was decided to leave this space open and invite guests to speak as and when required. Suggested speakers were the Environment Agency, BGS and the independent well examiner.

### **Chair**

It was agreed that the group would elect a chair via a postal vote. The group facilitator will write to the group asking for self-nominations and once a short list has been identified, the chair will be elected by postal ballot.

### **Future Agenda**

The group discussed topics they would like considered at future meetings. It was decided that since the group was not familiar with the planning application, a good starting point would be an

introduction to the scheme. This may answer questions or throw up new areas for investigation. Other areas identified were:

- Traffic – the group would like a workshop on this
- Technical – well design and specifications
- Light
- Noise
- Community fund
- UK content
- Water monitoring boreholes
- Geology
- Waste water
- Chemicals
- Well site visit – the group would like a site tour. Group facilitator to identify suitable times and dates
